The declaration to form a Cemetery Maint Dist.

ORDER

The Board of County Commissioners, Grand County, State of Utah, having on the 12th day of November, 1956, canvassed the votes cast in the 1956 General Election in regard to the Grand County Cemetary Maintenance District, and having found that more than one half of all qualified voters in said county voted in favor of said Grand County Cemetary Maintenance District now makes this order which shall be entered in the minutes of the Board of County Commissioners declaring that the Grand County Cemetary Maintenance District is duly organized as a cemetary maintenance district under the name designated in the petition.

In compliance with Title 8, Chapter 1, Section 7, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, it is hereby ordered that the Grand County Cemetary Maintenance District is duly organized as a cemetary district under the name designated in the petition.

## O R D E R

The petition for the creation of a cemetery district filed by the residents of Moab, Grand County, Utah, having been noticed for public hearing at this regular meeting of the Board of County Commissioners of Grand County, in the County Courthouse this 20th day of August, A. D. 1956, and no person having appeared to protest the creation of such a district, and the Board having considered the boundaries of the lands described in said petition and being of the opinion that the lands described therein are sufficient for the use of such district, the boundaries of the district were defined as follows:

All of the lands situated in Grand County, Utah, shall be included within said district, and that the boundaries of said district shall be the same and identical with the boundaries of said County. A map of said proposed district is attached hereto.

The Board being fully advised finds and determines that public necessity and the welfare of the proposed territory and of the inhabitants thereof requires the formation of a cemetery district, and also finds and determines that the petition complies with the provisions of Sec. 8-1-1, Utah Code Annotated, 1953, and further finds the petition to be genuine and the petition and notice sufficient and in accordance with the requirements of Sec. 8-1-4 and Sec. 8-1-5, Utah Code Annotated, 1953.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY ORDERED: That the Board of County Commissioners have found that the public necessity and welfare of the territory and the inhabitants of Moab requires the formation of a cemetery district within the boundaries as determined and defined as follows:

All lands situated in Grand County, Utah.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the territory within the boundaries so fixed and determined be created a cemetery district, under the name "GRAND COUNTY CEMETERY MAINTENANCE DISTRICT", and the Clerk of this Board is hereby directed to immediately cause to be filed a copy of this order in the office of the Grand County Clerk, and thereafter the District named herein shall be noticed for an election to be held in such proposed cemetery maintenance district as provided for in Sec. 8-1-5, Utah Code Annotated, 1953.
