

Grand County/ Sand Flats Recreation Area Group Campsite Policies

- Reservable group campsites are E-1 and E-2. There is no water or dump station.
- The trip leader is responsible for paying for all reserved nights upon arrival at the entrance booth. If arrival is after hours you must pay the following morning.
- The \$10 reservation fee and camping fees are non-refundable.
- There is a maximum of 16 people in site E-1 and E-2.
- Group campsite E-1 is closed off with a cable gate. You can let yourself in when you arrive. A calendar is posted at both sites that show your reservation.
- Vehicles must fit in the parking area provided.
- In case of emergency call 911. For after hour noise complaints call the Grand County Sheriff's office at 435-259-8115.
- The group leader is responsible for being familiar with all posted rules and regulations for the Sand Flats Recreation Area outlined below and for ensuring other members of the group adhere to these rules. The group may be asked to leave by the Management or Law Enforcement for noise complaints, facility or resource damage. The leader may receive a citation for excessive noise during quiet hours or resource or facility damage to the site.

Sand Flats Recreation Area Rules and Regulations:

- Bicycles, ATV's, motorcycles and 4x4's must stay on designated roads and trails and in parking areas in campsites. Respect your neighbors and limit the use of motorized vehicles while in the campgrounds. Operation of motorized vehicle or mountain bike off designated roads and trails is a class A misdemeanor punishable by fine, imprisonment and/or forfeiture of vehicle.
- Tents should be set up only in the impacted area of the campsite and should not be placed on vegetation.
- Build fires in metal fire ring provided. Bring in your own firewood, but no wood pallets. Do not collect wood or organic material. Do not put rocks or trash in the fire ring. Fire must be cold to the touch when you leave camp. Use water to put your fire out; not sand.
- Do not litter. A trash dumpster is located at the Slickrock Bike Trail parking lot. A recycling center is located 1 mile west of the entrance station on the Sand Flats road.
- Use vault toilets provided. Do not put trash in the toilets.
- Quiet hours are 10 pm to 6 am. No generator use 8 pm to 8 am.
- Check in time is 1 pm. Check out time is 11 am.
- No Shooting or Fireworks.
- Dogs must be kept under restraint. Please clean up after your pet.
