By virtue of the authority vested in me through the laws of the State of Utah, I now pronounce you [Spouse 1] and [Spouse 2] legally married.

I understand that a marriage license is only valid within thirty (30) days of issuance. If the marriage ceremony has not been completed within thirty (30) days, the license must be returned to the Clerk's office and reissued.

I agree that I will not officiate in a marriage unless two witnesses (18 years of age or older) are present to attest to the marriage. These witnesses must be someone other than the officiator and the marriage applicants, and must sign the license.

I will ensure that the official marriage license is filled out accurately and completely, including all necessary signatures.

I will return the official license to the Grand County Clerk's office within thirty (30) days of performing the ceremony. Failure to do so may result in the designee being charged with a misdemeanor under U.C.A. § 30-1-11 (1953), as amended.

Upon completion of a marriage ceremony, I will complete the marriage certificate and provide it to the applicants to be used as a keepsake.
